GREETINGS!

The sages tell us (Berachot 28: 1) the day that Rabbi Eliezer ben Azariah ascended to be the head of the yeshiva in Yavneh, they removed the guard at the entrance so that no one who was not among them would enter. He declared, “Everything will enter.” On that day, many benches were added to the beit midrash.

Baruch Hashem, we have many prospective students knocking on our doors (150 applicants per year for 36 first year students), asking to be accepted and to study with us.

We plan on opening a new “sister” yeshiva that will allow us both to grow and at the same time enable us to have the same personal contact with each student.

The new yeshiva will begin operation this Elul and will be located temporarily in Tapuach until we move to our new permanent home on land that has been given to us by the Shomron Regional Council in a new Yishuv, West Tapuach. Yeshivat Hesder Avinoam is named in memory of our dear student, Lt. Avinoam Cohen z’l who was killed during the course of a training mission in the Golan prior to Yom Kippur 5778.

We would be grateful if you would be partner with us in our continued expansion in Tapuach and Please God, together we will continue to grow and beautify the learning of Torah in Eretz Yisroel in general and the Shomron in particular.

BUILDING HISTORY...

5740 (1980)

A kollel for married men was opened in temporary buildings in the community of Elon Moreh.

5755 (1995) Rabbi Elyakim Levanon becomes the Rosh Yeshiva of Yeshivat Hesder Elon Moreh which is merged with the kollel. The yeshiva is located in two portable structures that serve as a beit midrash and dining room in the Neveh Ofra neighborhood in Elon Moreh.

5760 (2000) The yeshiva moves to its current location.

5773 (2013) A state of the art kitchen facility and dining room are built.

5777 (2017) An expanded beit midrash and additional classroom space are added to the existing educational facility.

5779 (2019) Establishment of Yeshivat Hesder Avinoam in Tapuach.



THE AVINOAM BEIT MIDRASH PROJECT

The decision to open Yeshivat Hesder Avinoam is the essence of what we teach in Elon Moreh. Our students are taught the importance of taking action and building the Land of Israel. Thanks to our partnership with the Shomron Regional Council we have merited to continue the pioneering spirit of those that established our country 70 years ago. Yeshivat Avinoam will play a crucial role in the creation of a continuum of yishuvim between Ariel and Tapuach.

The establishment of the Yeshiva is a natural outgrowth of the tremendous demand of young men who are attracted to the educational approach and philosophy of Rav Levanon.

We have already begun the process of recruiting a group of 25 first year students who will serve as the nucleus of the yeshiva. This group of first year students will be joined by an additional 10-15 senior students from Elon Moreh as well as five married couples from our Kollel. Please G-d on the first of Elul 5778 with your help, the beit midrash in Tapuach will be filled with about 50 young men. They will fulfill the saying "They will produce Torah with their mouths and settlement with their bodies".

As we lay the cornerstone of Yeshivat Hesder Avinoam, with G-d's help we will continue to expand both the building of the Torah and the Land!
